Gad V., 36, a reserve soldier who was injured in Lebanon on August 9, 2006. Gad sustained multiple shard injuries in the left side of the body - leg, arm, ear and eye. He also suffered from significant muscle loss and the loss of sensation in the leg.

Gad's wife Sharon, a computer programmer, lost her job after spending several weeks in the hospital with her husband. The family has two children, 1.5 and 3.5.

Before the war Gad worked installing equipment on high-rise buildings. Due to his injuries he won't be able to return to the same profession.
