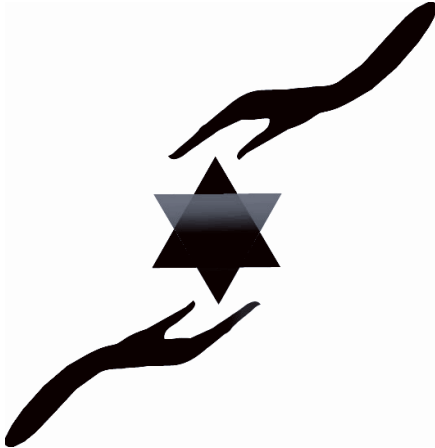

## 2008 Distribution List

- 1. Denis T. (27)** – reserve soldier; during 2006 Lebanon war had suffered severe spine injury and was immobile for a long time – without money or help. Denis repatriated to Israel at age 13 with a grandmother, who later died; he is very lonely. **\$1800**
- 2. Irina G. (42)** – husband Lev C., 52, was killed at Nahal Oz oil terminal on April 9, 2008; daughter 12. **\$900**
- 3. Zhanna L. (36)** – husband Oleg (37) was killed at Nahal Oz oil terminal on April 9, 2008; son 9. **\$900**
- 4. Gila and Meir C.** – in summer 2007 their oldest daughter and her husband were killed in a terror attack in Samaria, a mere two months after their wedding. This has broken Meir, and in July 2008 he suffered a severe stroke and cannot work. The family has several younger children. **\$1,000**
- 5. Yury A. (57)** – seriously injured in Netania bombing 5/18/2001, 100% disabled; lives alone. **\$300**
- 6. Evgenia M.** - son Boris (16) seriously injured in Beer Sheva 8/31/2004, mother 100% disabled, single mother, very needy. **\$300**
- 7. Galina G. (44)** – lost a leg in the bombing in Haifa in summer 2006. Came to Israel 1.5 years ago with a husband (64), before the accident Galina worked as a janitor in a supermarket, her husband was cleaning streets; very needy. **\$400**
- 8. Asaaf A. and in-laws Galina and Gennady P.** – apartment completely burned due to direct hit by Kassam, Sderot, March 7, 2008. Gennady covered granddaughter with his body. Nobody was injured, but all the belongings were lost. **\$1000**
- 9. Yuri(53) and Rimma (49) U.** – their apartment in Sderot destroyed by fire caused by Kassam rocket on March 7, 2008 **\$500**
- 10. Alexander (56) and Lubov (47) V.** – their house in Sderot has been repeatedly hit by Kassams and seriously damaged, although livable. Both handicapped (65% and 28% disability). He suffers from cancer, she - from spinal injury. Very little income. **\$500**
- 11. Ora and David C.** – Entire family (parents and 5 children) were wounded in bus bombing in Jerusalem in August, 2003. Still need surgeries to remove shrapnel. **\$500**
- 12. Elizabeth G.** – Died in bulldozer attack in Jerusalem on July 2, 2008. She was a single mother raising three children alone, now they are orphaned: Tzvi, 22, Issachar, 19 and Yael 17. **\$500**

- 13. Lior Sh. (32)** – Injured by Kassam in Sderot in August 27, 2007. Lost one eye, vision in the other eye was partially restored after several surgeries. Before his injury worked as a taxi driver; now needs retraining to have an income. **\$500**
- 14. Michael G.** – his elderly parents were victims of Dimona attack on February 5, 2008: his mother died, while his father sustained very severe injuries to the abdomen. **\$300**
- 15. Ilana B.** – Seriously injured in Ariel entrance bombing in 2004; still needs treatment and very needy. **\$300**
- 16. Lapid School** – a non-profit volunteer-based organization that offers tutoring, medical and psychological help to teenagers and young adults who were victims of terror. **\$4,120**
