## 2006 Financial Report

**Total raised: \$24,500**

**Total delivered: \$22,850**

**Operational expenses: \$450**

**Remains on the account (December 31, 2006): \$1,200**

**The money was raised at the Benefit Concert & Art Show (March 26, 2006),  
through private donations and \$1000 grant from RJCF**

- 1. Boris G. (36)** – wife Larisa, 36 is in coma since bombing at Hadera market on 10/25/2005; three children 11, 4 & 3. **\$2,800**
- 2. Vitaly P. (70)** – severely injured in both legs, wife Genya died in bombing at Hadera market on 10/25/2005. **\$500**
- 3. Yury A. (56)** – seriously injured in Netania bombing, 100% disabled. **\$750**
- 4. Evgenia M.** - son Boris (14) seriously injured in Beer Sheva 8/31/2004, mother 100% disabled, single mother with three children, very needy. **\$1,800**
- 5. Andrey M. (23)** – serious head injuries sustained in Beer Sheva bus bombing 8/31/2004, lives alone. **\$500**
- 6. Alexander U. (23)** – severe injuries sustained in Delphinarium bombing 6/1/2005, needs continuous treatment. **\$500**
- 7. Yury Ch. (56)** - severe injuries sustained in bus station bombing in Tel Aviv 7/11/2004. 100% disabled. **\$500**
- 8. Vitaly P. (30)** – multiple severe head and body injuries sustained in bombing at the Rehov market in Netania 5/19/2002. Disabled and depressed; has wife and two young children. **\$500**
- 9. Margarita S. (27)** – she and her 3 year old daughter sustained severe burn injuries in Netania shopping center bombing 7/12/2005. **\$1000**
- 10. Moisey A. (20)** – sustained serious injuries in park bombing in Rishon le-Zion 5/22/2002. Lives with parents – father disabled, mother cleans houses; very needy. **\$500**
- 11. Radmira Sh. (26)** – lost husband David (29) in bombing near Tel Aviv restaurant 4/17/2006. Radmira was 9 months pregnant with her third child when she became a widow. **\$1,300**
- 12. Larisa A. (20)** – injured in Delphinarium bombing 6/1/2001; mother died of cancer 6/1/2003. **\$400**
- 13. Natalia S.** – lost son Sergey in Delphinarium bombing 6/1/2001, suffers from cancer, lives alone, does not work. **\$500**
- 14. Marina Z. (20)** - badly injured in the head in Delphinarium bombing 6/1/2001; had multiple neurosurgeries, metal objects still remain in the head. Suffers from depression, PTSD and severe headaches. **\$400**
- 15. Pavel S. (33)** – severe injuries sustained while working as a security guard in Beer Sheva; lives alone, cannot work. **\$600**
- 16. Katya P.** - severe head and leg injuries sustained in Delphinarium bombing 6/1/2005. Needs continuous treatment, lives with parents, very needy family. **\$300**
- 17. Gregory and Raisa N.** – lost daughter Irina in Delphinarium bombing 6/1/2005. Gregory suffers from cancer and does not work, Raisa works as a home health aid; very needy. **\$400**
- 18. Yitzhak D.** – seriously injured in Tel Aviv night club bombing 2/25/2005. Has one 4 year old daughter. **\$300**
- 19. Yoel and Limor H.** – both seriously injured in Tel Aviv night club bombing 2/25/2005. Have two children, 9 and 6. **\$300**
- 20. Benny M.** - seriously injured in Tel Aviv night club bombing 2/25/2005. Has three children, 5, 4 and 1 year old; wife does not work. **\$300**

- 21. Dmitry K. (32)** – was wounded on August 9, 2006 – first in the back, then during rescue under fire - into the abdomen. Barely survived, had two surgeries. Shards still remain in kidney and internal organs. Faces long and difficult recovery. Permanent disability is likely. Married, has 3 year old daughter. **\$800**
- 22. Moti D. (24)** – very seriously wounded soldier, still bed-ridden. His older sister, who is a single mother with three young children, takes care of him. Very needy family. **\$500**
- 23. Eugene G. (24)** – very seriously wounded on August 6, 2006. Over 1000 shards all over the body, badly damaged right leg: due to the damage of main artery it did not have blood circulation, gangrene has started and over one-third of leg muscle had to be removed to stop the process. **\$1,000**
- 24. Itay P. (29)** – very seriously wounded on May 2, 2006: shards badly damaged bones of right leg, left arm is almost paralyzed. **\$500**
- 25. Ruth Z.** – was hit by Kassam rocket in spring of 2004 as she was going to the daycare with her 3-year old son. Her son was killed, Ruth lost one leg, and the second one was badly damaged. She spent 10 month in the hospital; just started to make first steps again earlier this year; lives alone. **\$500**
- 26. Kirill G. (21)** – died in Gaza 10/2006. Check to his parents. Mother suffers from cancer. **\$500**
- 27. Vadim G.** - draft soldier, was wounded in Lebanon in summer 2006; Draft soldier, serious abdomen wounds; will require lengthy recuperation during which will not be able to work. Wanted to become a career officer, now will not be able to. **\$400**
- 28. Tomas S.** - draft soldier, was wounded in Lebanon in summer 2006; serious abdomen wounds; underwent multiple surgeries. **\$400**
- 29. Alex T.** - draft soldier, was wounded in Lebanon in summer 2006; suffered a serious head wound, had brain surgery. Will require very lengthy recuperation, will have disability. **\$400**
- 30. Gur N.** - draft soldier, was wounded in the face in Lebanon in summer 2006; the bullet went into the mouth and exited through the left ear; stayed in the hospital for three months, still continues rehabilitation treatment. Gur will need more surgeries for reconstruction of facial bones, hearing and neurological problems. **\$500**
- 31. Liza K. (65)** – widow of **Mikhail K. (68)** who died in Hadera market bombing on 10/25/05. **\$200**
- 31. Zaka Rescue and Recovery** **\$1,000**
- 32. Lapid School** – non-profit volunteer-based organization that offers tutoring, medical and psychological help to teenagers and young adults victims of terror. **\$2,000**
